Public hearing to consider a Request for Determination of Applicability filed by Five D Realty Trust for the installation of 17 parking spaces, sidewalks, and two raingardens within the 200-foot Riverfront Area or the Bordering Land Subject to Flooding. The project is located at 366 Pleasant Street.
2. Public hearing to consider a Request for Determination of Applicability filed by 162 Pond Street Realty Trust, Michael Kane for the installation of a 230-foot x 60-foot storage building, the installation of pavement areas and relocation of fencing portions of which are within the 100-foot Buffer Zone. The project is located at 162 Pond Street.
3. Public hearing to consider a Request for Determination of Applicability filed by 158 Pond Street Realty Trust, Michael Kane for drainage improvements and grading, and resurfacing of the parking area in the 100 foot buffer zone. The project is located at 166 Pond Street.
4. Continued public hearing to consider a Notice of Intent and application for Stormwater Management Permit filed by Steve Ross, Chelcie Development LLC, for the construction of a seven-lot subdivision on a 20.69 acre parcel of land, including a 690 foot road and associated site work and utilities, portions of which are within the 100-foot buffer to bordering vegetated wetlands. The project is located on Whittemore Drive.

5. Public hearing to consider Notice of Intent and application for Stormwater Management Permit filed by Mark Orlando for the construction of a garage, paved driveway, storage area, utility connections, drainage and stormwater work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone. The project is located at 0 Megunko Road.

6. Continued public hearing to consider a Notice of Intent and application for Stormwater management Permit filed by Daniel DeMarco, Campanelli Acquisitions II, for the construction of a multi-unit apartment building complete with associated parking, clubhouse, landscaping, stormwater management and other utilities, and an emergency access road to High Street, portions of which are within the 100-foot buffer zone for bordering vegetated wetlands. The project is located on the MBTA access road.

7. Public hearing to consider Abbreviated Notice of Resource Area Delineation for the delineation of a bordering vegetated wetland, located at 0 Tri Street.

8. Amended Order of Conditions 95-0866, revised plans for updated Operations and Maintenance Plan for stormwater systems.
