### MEETING MINUTES ROADWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MARCH 24, 2016

Officer were elected by the committee - The Chair of the Committee will be Ed Burman and the Vice Chair is Nat Strosberg

Ed Burman started the meeting with a discussion on how items will be brought to the committee's attention. An email will go out to all town employees advising them if they get complaints about signs, streetlights, roadway issues they can email or mail the information to Ed Burman who will forward them to the committee members and they will be discussed at the next meeting. This will also enable the committee to follow up with the people that are having any roadway and traffic safety issues. The committee also discussed how we may have to do certain studies and also seek funding to solve some of the issues.

The committee also discussed the parking spaces in front of the Ashland Public Library, David Manugian will be getting information on how much distance is needed between a parking space and a crosswalk and this will be scheduled to be repainted so that the crosswalk is in compliance.

There was also discussion on future projects, one was a discussion on the signal lights at Fountain and Front Streets and Union and Fountain Streets, these are owned by the state but when the bridge project is done in Framingham, the town needs to look at possibly purchasing these lights from the state but not until the sensors are working properly and they are up to date.

The committee also discussed the possibility of purchasing a sign making machine to upgrade our signs around town or find a way to possibly rent the one that Framingham has from time to time.

The committee also recommended that we allow two more residents on the committee that have sent in Talent Bank Forms, Joe Magnani stated he would get this on the agenda for the next BOS Meeting for a discussion.
