The Committee considered articles relevant to the mission and charge of the OSRC. The articles reviewed and the position of the OSRC on these articles were:

- Article 18: Purchase of Girl Scout Camp – Support; per motion by Ms. Shields, seconded by Ms. Sallet, the OSRC voted (5-0) to support.
- Article 21-23: Planning Board design and zoning changes – No Position
- Article 24: Accept Trail Easement – Support; per motion by Ms. Sayed, seconded by Ms. Shields, the OSRC voted (5-0) to support.

Upon motion by Ms. Sayed, and seconded by Ms. Shields, the Committee voted (5-0) to adjourn the meeting at 9:37 p.m.
