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10 Mr. Ladd called the meeting to order at 7:30.  
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12 Mr. Correia, from the Ashland DPW, said that he has the cost figures on the batting cages and  
13 the scoreboard that are part of the proposed upgrade to the Middle School fields. Mr Correia  
14 also said that he had not yet been able to get a quote on the proposed tennis courts. Mr. Ladd  
15 reviewed the timelines necessary for Mr. Correia to prepare a proposal that would be ready for  
16 the fall Town Meeting while stressing that the Committee needed to have the completed  
17 application by the summer. Ms Saul praised the DPW for getting the application process  
18 started.

20 Ms Saul asked for an update on the Valentine property. Ms. Van Lancker reported that the  
21 Valentine Committee was working toward getting a quote to fix the barn roof and that they had  
22 presented their plans to the Conservation Commission.

24 Mr. Ladd presented an update on the Marathon Park project stating that the work may start in  
25 May or June. He also reminded the Committee that every spring the CPC finances are shared at  
26 the spring Town Meeting including what is owed, and the bond payments due. Mr. Ladd also  
27 told the Committee that the Oat St and High School bonds would be paid off in the next year.

29 Ms. Van Lancker moved to approve April 5, 2022 minutes as amended. Ms. Saul seconded the  
30 motion. The motion passed 6-0-0.
