



Application for Annual Dog License 2023

In accordance with Chapter 140 of the Massachusetts General Laws and Chapter 87 of the Town of Ashland's bylaws all dogs over 6 months of age must be vaccinated against rabies and must be licensed and tagged. 2023 Fees: \$15 for spayed or neutered dog with proof from a licensed veterinarian and \$20 for intact dogs. Owners who are seventy (70) years of age and older are exempt from the dog license fee. A copy of a valid Mass driver's license or passport must be included in order to be exempt from the fees. Please note that the exemption does not apply to kennel licenses.

For each dog, you will need to:

- Provide valid Massachusetts Rabies Certificate. (We will return with your tag(s))
- Completely fill out the owner and animal information on the application.
- Provide a check or money order payable to the Town of Ashland.

***Please note*: Failure to properly license your dog(s) by April 15, 2023 shall result in a \$50.00 fine for each dog.**

**** It is the owner's responsibility to notify the Town Clerk's Office if a dog has moved out of town or is deceased. ****
