

## Sudbury Access Facility – Emergency Response Procedure (Release of Containments)

### *Emergency Spill Response Clean-Up Materials and Equipment*

95 Gallon Spill kits will be maintained onsite for spill control. These kits will be located in a storage trailer or staging area. Spill kits will include:

- Absorbent pads and booms for absorbing/surrounding liquid spills.
- Granulated adsorbent (e.g., cat litter) for collecting liquids.
- Polyethylene sheeting.
- 55-gallon drums for containerization of waste materials.
- “DO NOT ENTER” plastic marking tape.
- Oil Absorbent Mat Pads (15” x 30”, approximately 100 each)
- Oil Absorbent Booms (3” & 5” diameter, approximately 100 LF)

### *Spill/Release Contingency Measures*

Personnel observing a spill or release will notify the Project Superintendent and Project Manager immediately. Personnel will attempt to contain the spill at the source, if deemed safe to do so. The Project Superintendent / Project Manager will notify appropriate parties (Town of Ashland Fire Department 508.881.2323 & MassDEP’s Emergency Response 888.304.1133) of the spill and determine if additional air monitoring and/or site evacuation is necessary based on the nature of the spill. Temporary containment berms, sumps, spill diversion and material transfer techniques shall be utilized to control and contain the spill.
